THE IRS
WILL
NEVER

- Call and demand immediate payment requiring a specific payment method, like a prepaid debit card, gift card, or wire transfer
- Demand payment for taxes without the opportunity to question or appeal the amount claimed that you owe.
- Threaten to bring in law enforcement (local police, immigration, or other enforcement) to have you arrested for not paying.
- Revoke your driver's license, business license, or immigration status.

THE IRS
WILL

- Generally, first, mail you a bill if you owe any taxes. Which you have the right to appeal.
- Advise you of your rights as a taxpayer
- If a representative calls or visits you, they will not demand immediate payment to a source other than the U.S. Treasury. The IRS will not call or visit without first attempting to notify you by mail.
- If a representative visits you, they will always provide two forms of credentials (pocket commission and HSPD-12). You have the right to see these credentials.
